MOTION BY COUNCILMAN ASHBROOK second by Councilman Dupy to approve the previous minutes (6/28/21). Motion passed with a vote of four yeas: Councilman Ashbrook voted yea; Councilman Dupy voted yea; Councilman Cunningham absent; Councilman Fosdick voted yea; Councilman Jarding voted yea.

accept the Mayor's recommendation to reappoint Don Ratliff to the Planning and zoning Board. Motion passed with a vote of four yeas: Councilman Ashbrook voted yea; Councilman Dupy voted yea; Councilman Cunningham absent; Councilman Fosdick voted yea; Councilman Jarding voted yea.

DARIN CHAPPELL, City Administrator, presented discussion regarding complaints of flooding in certain areas after heavy rain. Discussed the possibility of engineers doing a flood mitigation study. Consensus of the Council to direct City Administrator to talk with Engineers.
